Dear Parent/Carer of Y6

I am writing to let you know a little more details about Transition Day at Seaham High School, which is Thursday June 28th 2018. Students are expected to make their own way to and from school as they will in September. **Students should arrive and report straight to the Hall by 9am at the latest.** This will allow existing students to be in their tutor groups by then. Students should wear their Primary school uniforms and either wear or have with them footwear, which would be suitable for indoor or outdoor PE such as Trainers.

All students should bring their own Packed lunch. Those students entitled to Free School Meals will be given a packed lunch. Water is available from water fountains. Students will work in Tutor Groups and have the opportunity to complete team building activities throughout the day. The purpose is to enable them to meet children in their Tutor Groups that they do not know and work with them. Whilst we appreciate that this may be daunting it is an essential part of the transition process.

We have decided that we will release students at 3:15pm rather than 3:05pm. This is to allow some of the congestion that occurs on Station Road around 3pm to dissipate prior to Year 6 students being released. **Our main school gates are closed daily between 3:00pm and 3:15pm** to ensure the safety of students crossing so any parents arriving by car will be unable to access the site during that time. **We will extend this to 3:20pm on Transition day.**

A reminder that our INDUCTION EVENING is on TUESDAY 26TH JUNE

There will be two sessions one at 5:30pm and one at 7pm. This will be an opportunity to find out what Tutor Group your child is in, meet key staff, view the uniform and ask any questions you may have. Please bring proof of your child's identity such as a passport or birth certificate.

The presentation at 5:30pm is for those students whose surname begins with letters A-J.

The presentation at 7:00pm is for those students whose surname begins with letters K-Z.
