Dear Parent/Carer,

In September 2017 we wrote to parents informing you of changes to our structure for academic and pastoral support. This system is now fully embedded and has become an integral part of school life. We are now at the stage where we wish to make some minor refinements to this system and this letter outlines these changes.

Where changes to the Year Achievement Leader model have been made, these changes will come into effect after the May half-term in order to ensure a smooth transition before the start of the 2019-20 academic year.

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Year Achievement Leaders

Year Achievement Leaders will remain with students for the duration of their time in a Key Stage. For example, a student arriving in year seven will remain with the same **Year Achievement Leader** throughout both years seven and eight. They would then have a new **Year Achievement Leader** who would remain consistent for years nine, ten and eleven as they move through Key Stage Four. This change has been made to ensure that your son/daughter has the most specialised academic support available to them throughout key milestones in their education.

Year Managers

In order to ensure that both pupils and parents have consistency when dealing with issues relating to both attendance and behaviour, the Year Manager will remain consistent for the entirety of your son/daughters time at Seaham High School. You will therefore note that there are no changes to the Year Manager structure.
